Due to the hybrid design configuration of Sea Trucks’ DP3 vessel fleet, we offer our clients a wide range of versatile solutions for their project needs. This versatility allows Sea Trucks to cross over traditional market sector boundaries and offer the following range of services:

- Conventional services, involving EPIC of production platforms and associated pipelines

A flexible fleet

Sea Trucks owns and operates a fleet of new, flexible DP3 construction / accommodation vessels, based on a hybrid design configuration that combines the following key characteristics:

- A Class 3 Dynamic Positioning system that enables the vessel's position to be maintained in both shallow and deepwater environments
- Large unobstructed decks from stern to bow bulkhead
- The ability to install rigid pipe and / or flexible pipe
- High capacity cranes ranging from 270 tons to 1,800 tons, many of which have deepwater capability and active heave compensation systems
- Large accommodation capacity of between 298 and 469 persons



Jascon 28 is an accommodation / hook-up vessel suitable to perform a wide range of accommodation / hook-up services.



Jascon 30 is a shallow water pipelay construction accommodation vessel with modular S-lay pipelay equipment enabling the barge to combine various offshore construction duties in the oilfield.



Jascon 25 was built according to the Sea Trucks Group hybrid design philosophy and is one of the Group's four major deepwater pipelay construction vessels.



Jascon 34 is the sister vessel of Jascon 25 and one of the Group's four major deepwater pipelay construction vessels.



Jascon 31 is a deepwater construction accommodation vessel for both shallow and deepwater operations.



Jascon 35 will be of similar size and specification to Jascon 18.

Jascon 18 is the deepwater flagship of the Sea Trucks Group with its twin working decks, deepwater capable pipelay system and 1,800 t main crane.
