PROJECT OVERVIEW

- **Location** Escravos Offshore, Nigeria
- **Field waterdepth** 3 – 60 m
- **Installation period** Call-out contract June 2009 – June 2011 (extendable by third year)
- **Location** Ongoing
- **Vessel** *Jascon 2*
- **Description**
 Project management, installation engineering, procurement (except client supplied materials), fabrication, transportation, offshore installation, remedial painting (where applicable) and pre-commissioning of:
 - 5 nos pipelines with a nominal diameter of 6" (168.3 mm) in water depths of 5.5 m to 6.0 m
 - 10 nos platform stalk-on risers of various lengths

West African Ventures, the 100% Nigerian operating company of the Sea Trucks Group, was awarded a 2-year call out contract, commencing in June 2009, comprising management, engineering, transportation, installation and pre-commissioning of various diameters pipelines and platform risers. The contract is extendable by a third year.

For the shallow water environments in West Africa and in particular for this project, West African Ventures outfitted the Jascon 2 accommodation barge with a 300 tons main crane and pipelay equipment. The conversion has been engineered in-house and executed at the company's fabrication yard in Onne, Nigeria.
